



# Mr. Kolesnik's Classroom Procedures and Expectations 2008-2009

## Morning Routine:

- Students will line up outside the north door after the first bell and enter the room quietly .
- Students will put their backpacks away in their cubbies and have their Homework Binders at their desk.
- Students copy the agenda for the day from the front board, take out homework from the night before and complete Morning Work/Number of the Day in their journals.
- Any notes from home should be presented during this time.
- Students will receive a stamp/sticker in their agenda for completed homework and signed agenda. Completed homework is EXPECTED!

## Procedures:

- ALL backpacks should be placed in cubbies. Once they are put away, students may **not** go back to them unless given permission.
- Students should sharpen pencils **BEFORE** class begins. If they do not have a pencil or it needs to be sharpened, they need to either borrow one from another student or put a dull pencil in the bucket to take a sharpened one out.
- After their backpacks are put away, students should have the previous night's homework out at their desk and begin working on Morning Work/Number of the Day.
- NO sharpening during teacher instruction! **BIG** distraction!
- Students may use the restroom throughout the day as needed unless I am teaching a whole group lesson. Only **ONE** student at a time may be at the bathroom/sink area. Unless it is an EMERGENCY, **no** student may get up to use the restroom or water fountain while I'm teaching.
- Students may keep a water bottle at their desk.
- Students **ALWAYS** line up in number order (ABC order).

## Behavior Expectations:

- We will be going on field trips throughout the school year. Field trips are a privilege, and as a result students who receive 3 short form referrals or more than 1 long form prior to that particular field trip will not be permitted to attend. We expect all of our students to make good choices and serve as roll models for other students at Beachland!
- Consequences for making a bad choice are as follows:
  1. Student will receive a verbal warning.
  2. Student will lose 10 minutes off of recess (also if their agenda is not signed).
  3. Short Form sent home & student will miss entire recess (also, if student does not have homework completed).
  4. Office referral and/ or parent conference.
- Consequences for making good choices are as follows:
  1. Daily: stickers, tickets, praise
  2. Weekly/monthly: extra recess, special treat, recognition, certificates, homework pass, lunch in the classroom, etc.

Homework will be assigned nightly, Monday through Thursday. Students are responsible for writing their assignments in their agenda daily. **If your child shows you're their agenda, and it is blank, PLEASE don't sign it!** Assignments turned in late will automatically lose ten points, unless the student has been ill, or there has been a family emergency. Responsibility is an important life skill!
