Classroom Procedures and Expectations

Morning Routine

- Students will line up outside the north door after the first bell and enter the room quietly.
- Students will put Homework Binders at desks and put backpacks away in cubbies.
- Sharpen pencils for the day.
- Copy the agenda for the day from the front board.
- Homework from the night before should be left out to be checked.
- Complete "Morning Work/ Number of the Day" from the overhead.
- A helper will lead the class in The Pledge of Allegiance following announcements.
- Students will receive a stamp/sticker in agendas for completed homework and signed agenda.

Procedures

- ALL backpacks should be placed in cubbies. Once they are put away, students may not go back to them unless given permission.
- NO sharpening pencils during class! BIG distraction! If you do not have a pencil or it needs to be sharpened, you need to either borrow one from another student or put a dull pencil in the bucket to take a sharpened one.
- Unless it is an EMERGENCY, no student may get up to use the restroom or water fountain during instruction.
- Students will sign in to use the bathroom and sign out after exiting.
- Only ONE person by the water fountain/bathroom at a time!
- Students ALWAYS line up in number order.

Homework will be assigned nightly, Monday through Thursday. Students are responsible for writing assignments in agendas daily. Assignments turned in late will automatically lose ten points, unless the student has been ill, or there has been a family emergency. Responsibility is an important life skill!

Behavior Expectations

- Students are expected to exemplify the “Three B’s” EVERYDAY!
- We believe that EVERY child has the right to be educated. In order to ensure these rights, we expect the following rules to be observed:
 1. Treat others as you want to be treated.
 2. Keep hands, feet, and objects to yourself.
 3. Do what your teacher asks immediately.
 4. Raise your hand and wait for permission to speak.
 5. Come to class prepared.
- Consequences for making a bad choice are as follows:
 1. Student will receive a verbal warning.
 2. Student will lose 10 minutes off of recess (also, if their agenda is not signed).
 3. Short Form sent home & student will miss entire recess (no recess if student does not have homework).
 4. Office referral and/ or parent conference.
- We will be going on field trips throughout the school year. Field trips are a privilege, and as a result students who receive 3 short form referrals or more than 1 long form prior to that particular field trip will not be permitted to attend. We expect all of our students to make good choices and serve as roll models for other students at Beachland.
- Consequences for making good choices are as follows:
 1. Daily: stickers, treats, tickets, praise
 2. Weekly/monthly: extra recess, special treat, recognition, certificates, homework pass, etc.
