



## 😊Classroom Procedures and Rules😊



### Morning Routine

- Students will put their backpacks away in their cubbies and have their Homework Binders and two sharpened pencils at their desk.
- Students copy the agenda for the day from the front board, take out homework from the night before and complete Morning Work and Number of the Day.
- Helpers will do their designated jobs, teacher takes lunch count & attendance and leads the class in the pledge of allegiance.
- Students will receive a stamp/sticker in their agenda for completed homework and signed agenda.

### Procedures

- ALL backpacks should be in the cubbies near the south window. Once they are put away, students may not go back to them unless given permission. 😊
- Students should sharpen pencils BEFORE class begins. If they do not have a pencil or it needs to be sharpened, they need to either borrow one from another student or put a dull pencil in the bucket to take a sharpened one out.
- NO sharpening during class! BIG distraction! 😊
- Students are allowed to sign in to use the restroom on the clipboard by the sink as needed. They do not have to ask for permission; however, during direct instruction it must be an emergency only. Students also return to the same clipboard after exiting the restroom to write yes or no to clarify if they left the bathroom clean. (This helps keep track of messes that are made or inappropriate writing on the bathroom walls.😊)
- Students ALWAYS line up in number order which is ABC order. After the first of the year the order reverses to Z to A. All students know their number.

### Marvelous Monkey Behavior Expectations (No 'Monkey Business!')

- 😊 Students are expected to exemplify the "Three B's" EVERYDAY!
- 😊 I believe that EVERY child has the right to be educated. In order to ensure these rights, I expect the following rules to be observed:
  1. Treat others as you want to be treated.
  2. Keep hands, feet, and objects to yourself.
  3. Do what your teacher asks immediately.
  4. Raise your hand during instruction time and wait for permission to speak.
  5. Complete all class work and homework on time.

- ☺ The behavior pockets that will be utilized daily are on each student's desk. All students start the day with a green card which is marvelous. ☺
- ☺ When a student makes a poor choice the following will occur:
- ☺ Students know to change their card first thing in the morning to yellow for not completing homework.
- ☺ Disrespect, not following directions, unacceptable behavior in the lunch room, etc. are all reasons to ask students to change their card.

The color cards are in order as follows:

**Green**--- Magnificent

**Yellow**--- 10 minutes off of recess (also if agenda is not signed) Student will walk around the hard court

**Red** ---- Miss all of recess/ Short form sent home

- ☺ If a student continues to show poor choices and can't follow the rules he/she will be sent to the office and the parent will be contacted.

- **We will be going on field trips throughout the school year. Field trips are a privilege, and as a result students who receive 3 short form referrals or more than 1 long form prior to that particular field trip, will not be permitted to attend. We expect all of our students to make good choices and serve as roll models for other students at Beachland.**

### Consequences for Magnificent Behavior

1. Daily: stickers, treats, tickets, praise
2. Weekly/monthly: extra recess, special treat, recognition, certificates, homework pass, etc.

### Homework

Homework will be assigned nightly, Monday through Thursday. Students are responsible for writing their assignments in their agenda daily. Assignments turned in late will automatically lose ten points, unless the student has been ill, or there has been a family emergency. Responsibility is an important life skill!
